The ICC First Mate Scholarship is for on-campus residents demonstrating financial need. The ICC First Mate Scholarship is a waiver of the portion of tuition for up to thirty-six (36) credit hours. (15) Fall, (15) Spring and (6) Summer semester. Applicants will be awarded as funds are available and funding is not guaranteed. Should the number of qualified applicants exceed the number of waivers available, applications will be considered in the order they are received. The Fall/Spring priority deadline is Aug 1. The Spring priority deadline is Dec 1 and **Spring only** awards are reserved for first-time ICC students, subject to availability.

- ✓ Degree Seeking from Independence Community College
- ✓ Academic Requirements:
 - First- time Entering Freshmen: high school 2.0 GPA
 - Transfer Students: 2.0 GPA
 - Continuing ICC Students: 2.0 cumulative GPA
- ✓ Complete a 2026-27 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- ✓ Meet and maintain ICC's financial aid satisfactory academic progress standards
- ✓ Student must reside in on-campus housing for the academic year

Evaluation of Applicants

Applicants who have not attempted college credit will be evaluated on High school transcript submission. Applicants who have attempted college credit will be evaluated on retention GPA. All applicants must maintain a completion rate of 67% and have not attempted more than 95 credit hours.

Notification of Award

Successful applicants will receive an award notice via ICC email directing them to the Financial Aid Dashboard in the Self-Service portal to review awards. This scholarship does not include student fees and only covers the student's portion of tuition. Students are not eligible to receive more than one tuition scholarship.
